Daughters of Norway Constitution A Nonprofit Corporation Established in the State of Washington

ARTICLE I

Name and Definition

- Section 1. The legal name of this Order shall be Daughters of Norway, as stated in its Articles of Incorporation, filed with the State of Washington.
- Section 2. It shall be defined as a Grand Lodge consisting of all members of its subordinate lodges.
- Section 3. Daughters of Norway shall be a nonprofit entity under the auspices of IRS law as a 501(c)(8) corporation.

ARTICLE II

Purpose

The specific and primary purposes for which this Order of the nonprofit corporation is formed are:

- a) To unite into a sisterhood women who wish to preserve the Norwegian heritage;
- b) To maintain among members a knowledge of the history, culture, and language of Norway, and
- c) To build a strong support system and bond of friendship within the sisterhood.

ARTICLE III

Eligibility and Membership

To be eligible for Standard Membership in a subordinate lodge of the Daughters of Norway, or as an Associate Member with no lodge affiliation, prospective members shall:

- a) Be at least thirteen (13) years of age;
- b) Be of Norwegian, Danish, Finnish, Icelandic, Swedish, or Saami birth or descent; or
- c) Have, or had, a spouse or domestic partner of Norwegian, Danish, Finnish, Icelandic, Swedish, or Saami birth or descent; or
- d) Have a "slektning" (relative) married to a person of Norwegian birth or descent.
